





Inferences:

1. Alumni Showed displeasure regarding content of the syllabus and its practical usage.
2. The Alumni had appreciated the cooperativeness of the faculty members of the institute, and said that they acted as mentors.
3. Another area of concern was the dissatisfaction among the alumni regarding, opportunities generated by Placement team for the students
4. The alumni through their feedback expressed their displeasure regarding the quality of infrastructural facilities provided by the Institute.
5. From the feedback, it can be said that the activities conducted by the Institute for student's development was not satisfactory and were not effective, amongst the alumni.

Special Remarks:

1. Increase the number of books available in the library.
2. Maintenance & Cleanliness of washrooms and classrooms on a regular basis.
3. More number of interactive sessions to be conducted between Alumni and present students.
4. The institute should have a transport facility.
5. Separate Industrial tour for UG and PG Students to be organised.
