Following business was transacted during the meeting -

- 1. The Minutes of previous IQAC meeting, held on 27th April, 2019, were read and confirmed by all the members present.
- 2. Discussion on Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) Chairman, Dr. Lalit Khullar, enquired on the status of working on the AQAR for year 2019-20. Coordinator-IQAC, Dr. Sanjay Kavishwar, informed that the work has progressed to a substantial extent and that the AQAR report is expected to be ready by 10th August, 2019.
 Resolved that Coordinator-IQAC, Dr. Sanjay Kavishwar, speeds up the preparation work and progress of AQAR to ensure its timely completion by 10th August, 2019.
- 3. Result of BBA examinations Senior Teacher, Prof. Carol Rao, informed all that RTM Nagpur University results of BBA Semester II, IV and VI have been declared and that performance of our students is as mentioned below:

5. Result of MBA examinations – Senior Teacher, Dr. Yogesh Gharpure, informed that RTM Nagpur University results of MBA Semester-IV are declared and that performance of our students is as mentioned below:

He also informed that Chinmay Ukhalkar has topped among boys, with a CGPA of 8.29, and Gunjan Bisen has topped among girls, with a CGPA of 8.23, from MBA Sem-IV.

- 6. Training and Placements Senior Teacher, Dr. Praveen Mustoor, informed the members that more than 100 students have been placed, this year, so far. He appreciated the work done by placement team in this respect. IQAC Coordinator, Dr. Sanjay Kavishwar, suggested that a placement record be displayed on the college website, with mention of highest, lowest and average salary packages and also the number of offers received by students. Dr. Praveen Mustoor informed that the list of placed students has already been displayed on the college website and that the report shall be uploaded soon.
- 7. Celebration of important days Dr. Yogesh Gharpure, Senior Teacher, informed that 'world environment day' was celebrated on 6th June at college. The day was celebrated by planting indoor plants at the hands of faculty members and keeping these potted plants at identified spots. He also informed that a Yoga Session was conducted for the faculty members and non-teaching staff, on 21st June, at 9 AM, in college library, in order to commemorate 'International Yoga Day'. Two lady Yoga Trainers were invited to speak on importance of 'Yoga' in our daily lives and also to demonstrate and make faculty members perform simple yoga exercises.
- 8. MBA admissions Senior Teacher, Dr. Yogesh Gharpure, informed that the registration process for Document Verification and Common Admission Process (CAP) rounds for MBA

admission shall begin soon. He also informed that our college is an authorized Facilitation Centre (FC) for this and further stated that all the faculty members will be asked to inform students about this. Dr. Gharpure also informed that earlier registration on SAAR portal has been cancelled and that students have to register fresh for document verification and participation in CAP rounds.

"It is resolved that the Program Coordinators, with help from class teachers, shall inform students of our college being the facilitation centre for centralised MBA admission process. Desirous students seeking admission to MBA course can make use of online facilities set up at our college FC and also ask their friends and acquaintances to do so".

Since there was no further agenda to be discussed, the meeting concluded with a vote of thanks to the Chairperson.
