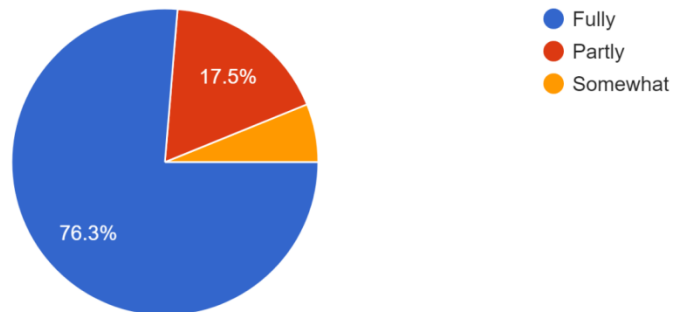

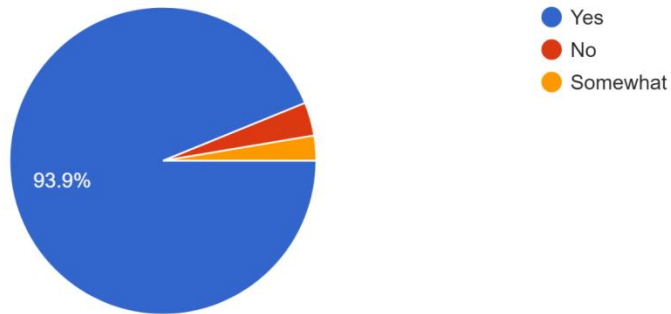

Inferences:

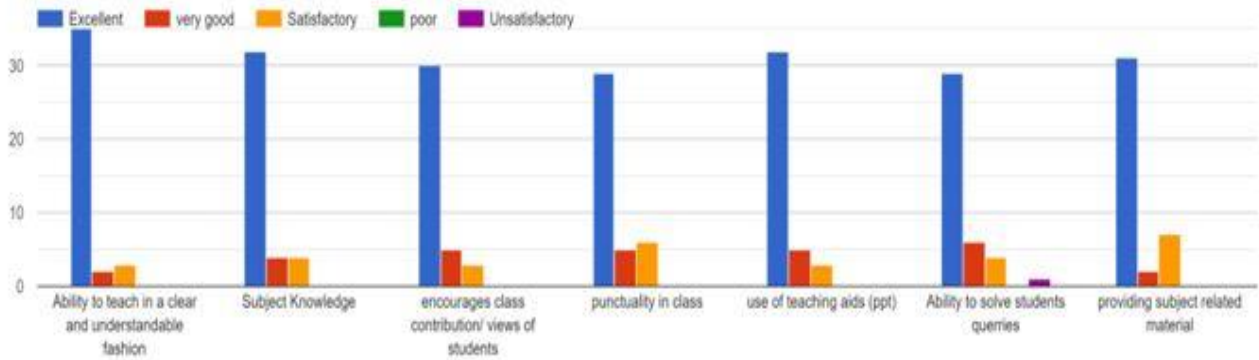
- Students found that the subject knowledge of the faculty members were good.

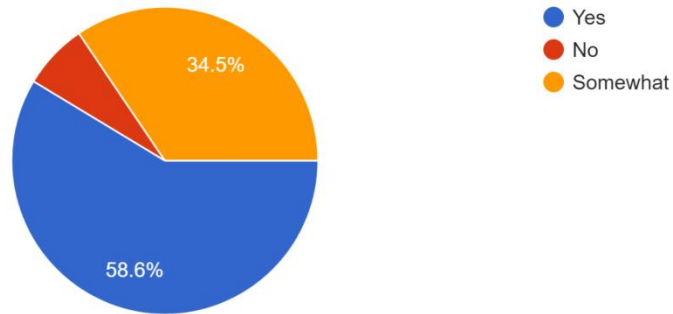

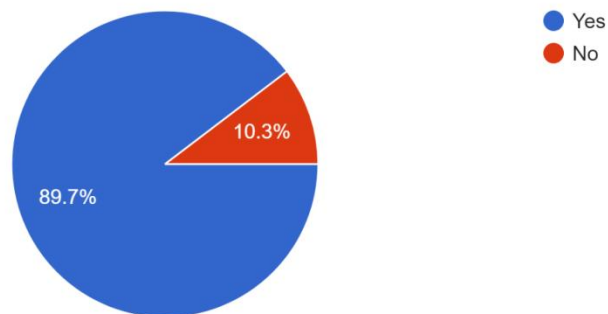

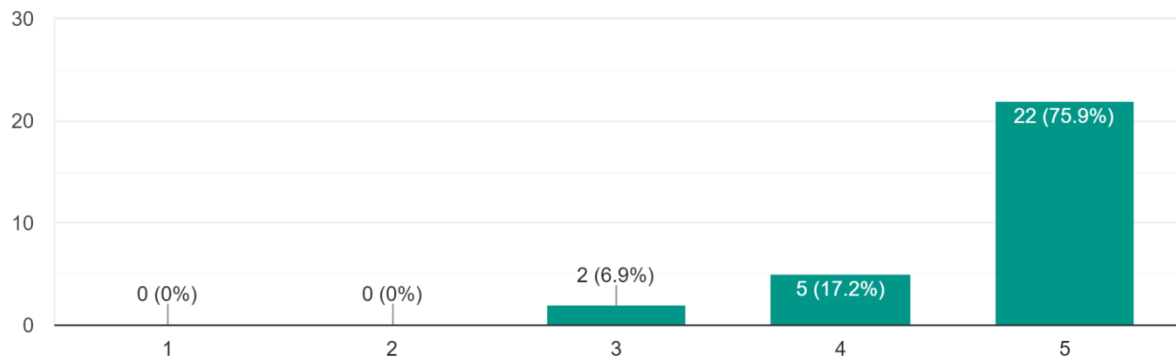

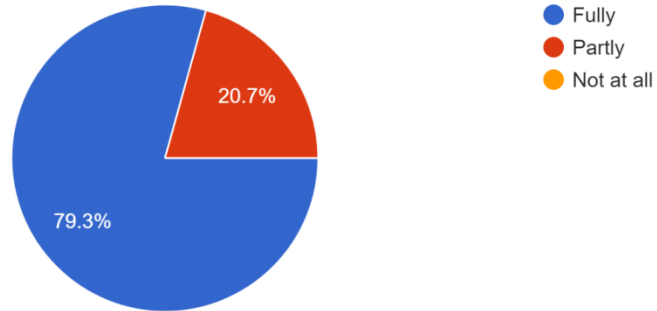

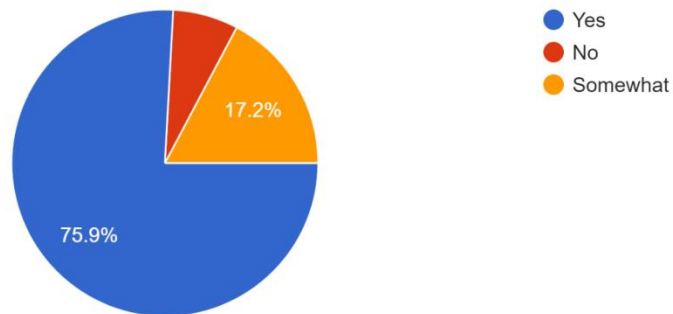

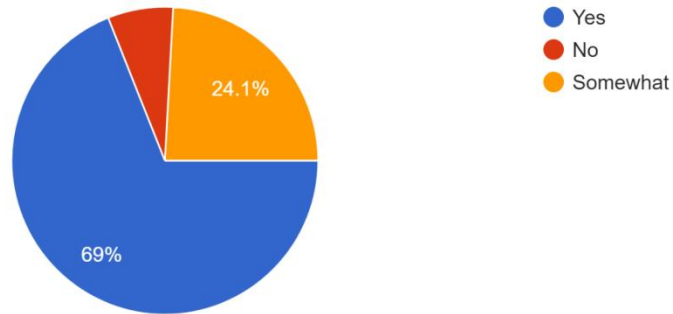

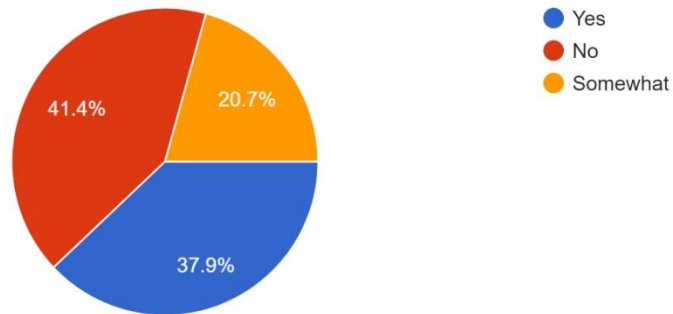

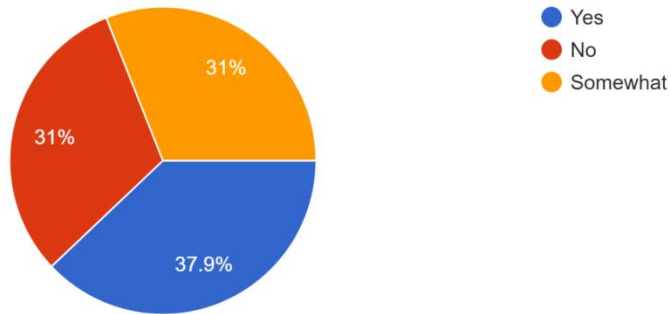

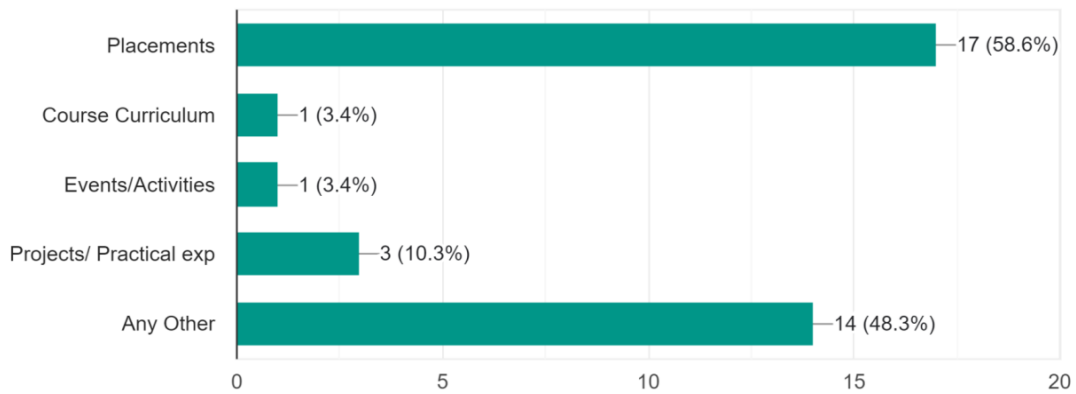

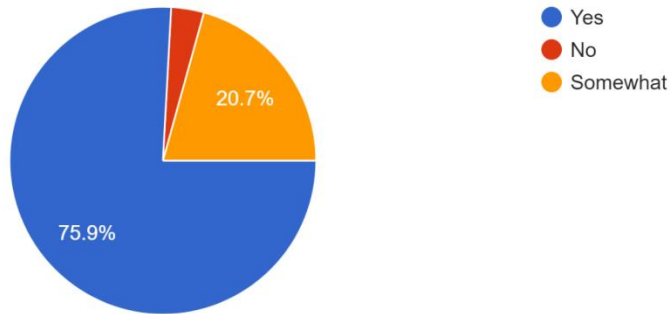
